**1 Peter 2:21-22** For even hereunto were ye called: because **Christ** also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no **sin**, neither was guile found in his mouth:

**1 John 3: 22** And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

### **What do we need to do in order to remain in Christ?**

**1 John 3:24** And he that **keepeth his commandments** dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

### **What is the proof that we love God?**

**John 14:15** If ye love me, **keep my commandments**.

**1 John 5:2** By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and **keep his commandments**.

### **What do we need to do in order to receive eternal life?**

**Matthew 19:17** And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? [there is] none good but one, [that is], God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

### **Who are they that will enter into the kingdom of heaven?**

**Matthew 7:21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

### **What is the will of the Father in heaven?**

**Psalms 40:8** I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law [is] within my heart.

### **How many commandments we have to keep?**

**Matthew 5:18** For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

### **How perfect is the Law of God?**

**Psalms 19:7** The law of the LORD [is] perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD [is] sure, making wise the simple.

### **Is the law of God difficult to follow?**

**1 John 5:3** For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

### **Where should the law of God be written?**

Hebrews 10:16 This [is] the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;
